In this package you will find 20 fun and thoughtful writing prompts for the month of March.

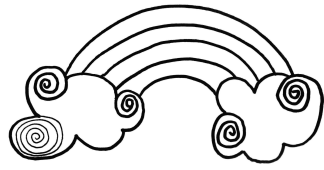

Describe a time when you were lucky.

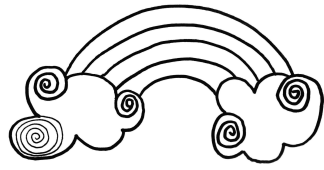
If you were a leprechaun where would you hide your treasure?
