Given there are 39 students attending, we feel that this is a suitable adult to child ratio. All water-based activities will be facilitated by fully qualified Department of Sport and Recreation staff.

Logistics:

- Students do not need to wear their uniforms to camp.
- In case of an emergency we ask that you please contact the school on **6274 1700** in the first instance, who will contact us.
- Spending money is not required; students will not have an opportunity to spend any money.
- Electronics are **not permitted**. This includes iPods, iPads, laptops, mobile phones and cameras. The risk of loss or breakage is too great, and we cannot insure against either of these things.
- Lollies, chocolate and energy drinks are **not permitted**.
- Students are encouraged to bring a book for nightly reading before lights out.
- Students can bring some card games and /or colouring in activities if they wish to do so. Please ensure students do not bring anything of value that could be lost.
