Hello Attadale Families,

The Book Week Parade is always a favourite for students, but I know it can be a bit of work and sometimes a little stress for parents. Thanks in advance for helping your children celebrate the parade. This year we are lucky to have local graphic novelist and illustrator, Aska presenting short interactive workshops to our students. Book Week reminds us of the importance of reading and the many learning opportunities that this opens up as kids master their skills. Everyone develops at their own pace and at Attadale PS we have programs and resources to cater for all students so they can continue to develop proficiency in this area. Our staff are skilled in the Science of Reading approach which is anchored in years of multi-disciplinary research on how children learn how to read and what matters most when teaching this important skill.

Last Friday we had a number of special visitors join our Kindy teachers and students for their morning outdoor play session. Visitors included Hon. Sabine Elisabeth Winton MLA BA; BPS, Lisa O'Malley MLA, Cheryl Townsend – Director of Education South Metro Education Region and representatives from the School's Curriculum and Standards Authority. The visit was part of the launch of the Kindergarten Curriculum Guidelines which have recently been revised. We were also lucky enough to spend time going through the updates and deepen our knowledge of what best practice looks like in this area which will assist in us continuing to provide a great early childhood experience for our students.
