2024 CLASS STRUCTURES

Class composition is a very comprehensive process that starts at the beginning of Term 4 each year. We ask that you trust in the expertise and dedication of our teachers and admin team to create the best learning cohort for your child, according to the structures available to us. As the professionals who observe your children directly in a classroom setting, class teachers are best placed to decide where the best 'fit' is for each child and work with the admin team and their phase colleagues to discuss placements.

Thank you to the parents who have provided constructive information that may assist us in placing their children. As in most years, our 2024 class structure may include a number of split classes. Due to numbers, split classes are a necessity in nearly all schools and while there is sometimes an initial level of concern, our genuine experience as educators always shows that students quickly settle into the wonderful classroom programs offered by each teacher and the new friendships formed.

To hopefully ease concerns and clarify any misinformation that may be present, we would like to state the following facts

- The overall guiding principle is to try, within the available structure, place each child in a class where their needs will have the best chance of being met. Within split classes, we are very mindful of ensuring an even spread across the academic, social and emotional spectrum. For example, Year 3 students in a 2/3 split are not been placed in this class due to being weaker academically, and Year 2 students in a 2/3 split are not been placed in that class due to being stronger academically. The same goes for students in any split or straight year class.
- Teachers deliver curriculum based on children's developmental levels, regardless of age. In fact, students in the following year level are often only a few months older in age (and sometimes only a few days).


SCHOOL OF INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC 2024 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The parent relayed that selection in the program gave their child a massive confidence boost and allowed them to discover an area of talent.

I mention this as a strong endorsement of the program as well as another request to parents to please carefully consider whether they wish to accept a place for their child. Despite regular reminders over the years we still have students leaving the program, sometimes because they are changing schools. This is hugely detrimental effect to the students remaining as they are left without peers in the small group program, reducing their motivation for their lessons. Late entry into the program is not permitted.

Offers for Year 2-4 students will be sent out shortly. Please carefully consider whether your child can commit to the program until the end of Year 6 at Attadale Primary.
