Dear parents


I am trying something new this year to attempt to expedite the process of selecting students for the clarinet, brass and flute programs during Year 5 and 6 at Attadale Primary. In previous years, some parents have been informed very late in the year about their child's place in the program due to the delay in responses from other families.

This year, I am asking parents to contact me if their child is interested in playing two or more of the instruments listed. Places are also dependant on student achievement in classroom music lessons and Instrumental Music Services testing. If selected, it is important that both you and your child fully understand the commitment required, before deciding to indicate interest in being considered for a final place.

Instrumental music skills do not bloom overnight! They are built carefully and steadily over a number of years, and success in the program requires sustained commitment by both children and parents. Please do not accept a place in the program if there is a chance that your child will not complete Year 6 at Attadale Primary.

If your child is interested in playing flute, clarinet and brass (trumpet and trombone) during Year 5 and 6, please contact me and I will provide more detail.
