I hope you all enjoyed the long weekend. Our School Development Day on Friday has given students a four day break from school and a chance to re-charge before we head into the last month of Term 2. Our staff spent Friday building their knowledge in two areas with teachers from neighbouring schools. The first part of the day was spent hearing about research in high impact teaching to support our whole school Instructional Model. We also had the opportunity to see some of these strategies in action with demonstrations from teachers from our network schools. After lunch we continued to build our knowledge in the area of ADHD and how to best support these students in the classroom. As a school we are always looking at ways to improve and these School Development Days are a valuable resource to utilise for this purpose.

ENROLMENTS FOR KINDY AND PRE PRIMARY 2025 ARE OPEN

Enrolments for Kindy and PP for 2025 are now open and will close on Friday July 19, 2024.

Kindergarten 2025

If you have a child who will turn 4 by 30 June 2025, they are eligible to enrol in Kindy in 2025.

Pre Primary 2025

If you have a child who will turn 5 by 30 June 2025, they are eligible to enrol in Pre Primary in 2025.

If your child is currently enrolled in Kindergarten 2024, they will need to enrol for Pre Primary in 2025. Pre Primary is the first compulsory year of schooling in Western Australia.
