A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

It has been a busy but calm and positive start to the term at Attadale Primary School, with our Year 6 Camp, the commencement of Edu-Dance, a respectful ANZAC service and our first whole-school assembly all setting a strong tone for learning and community. These experiences highlight the balance we strive for between engagement, wellbeing and high-quality learning for our students. As always, families are encouraged to regularly check the planner in the link above, which is kept up to date with all the important events and goings-on across the school.

This semester we are implementing changes to our semesterly reporting processes in line with Department of Education policy requirements. Reports will still include a grade and an effort rating for each learning area. Detailed strand information will be provided only for English (Reading & Viewing, Writing, Speaking & Listening) and Mathematics (Number & Algebra, Measurement & Geometry, Probability and Statistics) while a single global grade will be given for all other learning areas. Each student report will also include a general comment that reflects who your child is as a learner, incorporating their attitude, behaviour and effort, and outlining their progress in English and Mathematics across the semester. With a reduction in the amount of written evaluative detail within reports, opportunities such as parent-teacher interviews held last term become even more important. These conversations play a vital role in the school-parent partnership and support our shared focus on delivering the best possible education for every child.

One of the key drivers within our School Business Plan is to provide opportunities to support and upskill parents in the programs and strategies employed by the school. In line with this, our staff will be hosting a range of parent workshops designed to build understanding and increase transparency around our school direction and approaches to learning and wellbeing. Deputy Principal Caz Park will be presenting a session on precisely how students learn to read and managing reading difficulties on Thursday 14 May at 9am in the Library. Our school psychologist, Sarah Boyd, will run Fear-less – the Power of Positive Parenting on Thursday 18 June at 9am in the Library, sharing practical strategies to build resilience and reduce anxiety in childhood. We will also be offering several The Resilience Project parent-lens workshops, with dates and times to be confirmed, as well as Mathematics workshops next term in Term 3 facilitated by Ms Teede. We strongly encourage parents to attend these sessions as an important way to connect with the school's practices and better support learning at home.

A reminder that our School Board open meeting will be held tonight at 6pm. All interested community members are welcome to attend. It is a valuable opportunity to observe how the Board operates and to gain insight into its role, particularly for those who may be considering nominating when Board vacancies arise at the end of this year.

EXCURSIONS AND INCURSIONS

Compass Events is now fully in effect. All incursions and excursions will be communicated through Compass Events. When an event is available, it will appear as a banner at the top of your Compass app. By clicking on the event, you will be able to view all relevant details, including the date, time, and cost.

Before an event is published, administration will apply any available unallocated funds to your child's cost. For example, if an excursion costs \$30 and you have \$10 in unallocated funds, this amount will be applied, leaving a balance of \$20 to pay.

If no payment is required for an event, families are still required to provide consent by completing and submitting the form in Compass.

We will no longer be using the Audiri App in any capacity.
