CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

A reminder that 2026 contributions and charges are now due. Whilst being voluntary, money collected is used to supplement school expenditure across all learning areas. The quality of our teaching and learning programs are maximised when each family makes their voluntary contributions to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. The P&C voluntary contributions are used to pay for items not covered by government funding, or where there are government funding shortfalls. This includes funding for classroom supplies, school resources, learning subscriptions, and to continue the planned improvements to our school playgrounds, along with identified School Projects which are approved at P&C meetings.

Timely payment of these fees ensures that your child/ren can fully benefit from all the above educational opportunities and enhance their learning experience at Attadale Primary School.

AT HOME ACTIVITY

Take Control!

At home, younger children can play the Bubble Game by blowing bubbles and moving to pop them. Gradually add challenges such as only using certain body parts, not moving their legs, or staying completely still, then discuss how some things were outside their control and how they adapted. Older children can discuss:

- What is something you can control today?
- What is something you can't control?
- How can focusing on what you can control help when things don't go your way?
- What choices can you make when you feel upset or frustrated?
