## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Welcome back after a much deserved long weekend for everyone. The timing is ideal as we move past the halfway point of the term and head into what is always a busy and rewarding period of learning and school life. I hope everyone came through the weekend safely and that your roofs, fences and gardens have held up after what has been described as the strongest storm cell to hit Perth in 50 years.

Last week also marked National Reconciliation Week, an important time for all Australians. It is an opportunity to acknowledge both the ancient and modern histories of this country, and to reflect on our shared commitment to walking together towards a better future. At school, this is not about numbers or representation, but about ensuring all students develop into inclusive, respectful members of society who value others for who they are and the contributions they make. These understandings are central to the kind of community we continue to build together.

We continue to make steady progress in our transition to Compass as our central platform for attendance, communication, and most recently, payments and permissions for excursions. The aim is to create a genuine one-stop shop that streamlines processes and strengthens communication between home and school. As with any system, there are a few quirks we are working through. One example is the way replies to emails function—parents are able to respond directly to staff emails sent through Compass, but not to notifications such as merit award messages or classroom updates in the app. In some cases, replies to those notifications can appear to send but are not actually received. If you are ever unsure whether your message has reached a staff member, please feel free to contact the school directly or use the Compass app by clicking on your child's profile and selecting 'Send Email' to ensure your message gets through. If there's ever anything Compass-related you have feedback on or questions about, please don't hesitate to reach out as we work out the kinks and the best way to engage the community.

Finally, I encourage everyone to keep an eye on the term planner for the many events coming up over the next few weeks. These include EduDance concerts, a number of excursions, and our faction cross country. It promises to be a full and engaging end to the term, and we look forward to seeing many of you involved.

## COMPASS APP - EXCURSIONS AND INCURSIONS

Compass Events is now fully in effect. Thank you to all families who have seamlessly transitioned to the new system - this has made tracking consent and payments much easier.

*A reminder to please not pay online via direct bank transfer if you have already consented and paid in the Compass App.*

All incursions and excursions will be communicated through Compass Events.

When an event is available, it will appear as a banner at the top of your Compass app. By clicking on the event, you will be able to view all relevant details, including the date, time, and cost.

Before an event is published, administration will apply any available unallocated funds to your child's cost. For example, if an excursion costs \$30 and you have \$10 in unallocated funds, this amount will be applied, leaving a balance of \$20 to pay.

If no payment is required for an event, families are still required to provide consent by completing and submitting the form in Compass.

### Choosing a Gratitude Mindset

##### SHIFT FROM 'I HAVE TO' TO 'I GET TO'

A simple change in language from 'I have to do this' to 'I get to do this' can change our whole perspective on life and daily tasks. When we adopt the 'I get to' mindset as a gratitude practice, it helps us focus on the positive aspects of our lives and the opportunities we often take for granted.

##### HOW CAN YOUR FAMILY PRACTICE THIS TOGETHER?

Here are some examples to get you started:

- I get to wash the dishes.
- I get to make breakfast for my family.
- I get to walk the dog and spend time outside.

##### FAMILY CHALLENGE

Try to replace 'I have to' with 'I get to' in your conversations this week. Notice how it changes your perspective, and discuss as a family how it feels to focus on gratitude in everyday tasks.
