The quality of our teaching and learning programs are maximised when each family makes their voluntary contributions to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. This includes funding for classroom supplies, school resources, learning subscriptions, and to continue the planned improvements to our school playgrounds, along with identified School Projects which are approved at P&C meetings.

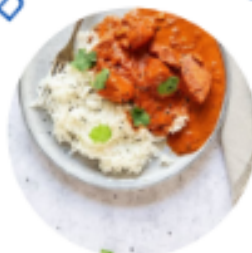
