With immediate effect, the school will not be requesting or accepting upfront payments for excursions and incursions as a result of the implementation of Compass Pay.

Compass Pay eliminates the need for these upfront payments as it allows you to pay directly from your debit/credit card which alleviates the need for credit on your accounts. In 2027 we plan to implement the ability to pay voluntary contributions and charges directly through the Compass app which, hopefully, will make parents lives that much easier.

In relation to cash payments, our preference is to move towards a cash-free front office wherever practicable, as this provides greater convenience and efficiency for our office operations. EFTPOS and direct bank deposits will, of course, always be available to parents who prefer those methods.

Vegetarian pizza scrolls

Yields: 10 servings Prep Time: 15 mins Cook Time: 10 mins Total Time: 25 mins

Ingredients

- Butter pastry
- Pizza sauce or tomato sauce and add a sprinkle of Italian herbs
- 1/4 cup mushrooms
- 1/2 cup capsicum
- 1/4 cup olives
- Grated cheese

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 200 degrees
2. Remove pastry from freezer to thaw whilst chopping veg
3. Chop all veg into small pieces
4. Add pizza sauce
5. Distribute veg evenly over pastry
6. Add cheese
7. Roll and cut into slices approx 3 cm thick, place on tray
8. Place in oven for 7-10 mins until golden
9. Cool on drying rack
